The Indian Ocean Cetacean Consortium (IndoCet) and the Indian Ocean Commission (IOC) Biodiversity Program funded by the European Union, are organizing a workshop on Cetacean research and conservation for the Indian Ocean region.

This will be held during the Humpback Whale World Congress (HWWC) on 6th July 2017 at the Museum **STELLA MATUTINA**, Piton Saint-Leu, Reunion Islands.

The purpose of this workshop is to introduce the newly initiated IndoCet Consortium to cetacean researchers in the region and open membership, promote exchanges on ongoing cetacean conservation and research efforts in the south-west Indian Ocean region, and encourage the development of partnership and regional cooperation.
